- Keep your pet inside
- Draw the curtains and turn on the radio/ television.
- Ensure your pet is micro chipped, as if frightened they can easily become confused and lost.
- Use Pheromone Therapy — These are available as plug in diffusers or sprays. They contain calming pheromones that comfort our pets in times of stress.
D.A.P. for dogs
Feliway for cats.
- Try Zylkene.

FIREWORK DONT'S

- * Overly reassure anxious pets as this will often reinforce the behaviour.

This is a natural product, new on the market, specifically developed to help pets overcome worrying periods, such as, firework stress, kennelling, etc..

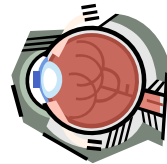

Keratoconjunctivitis Sicca or Dry Eye is a very painful condition that can lead to permanent blindness if not treated. Certain breeds, e.g. Spaniels, Westies, Yorkies are predisposed to insufficient tear production.
