The telephone will be answered by a duty member of staff who will need to take your name, the name of the animal or farm, your address and a contact telephone number. They will also ask for a brief description of the problem or reason for contacting the practice.

Please note your phone call may be recorded for quality control and training purposes.

The member of staff will then organise for the duty veterinary surgeon to return your telephone call as soon as possible, or organise an emergency appointment / visit.

Under normal circumstances we would ask that Pets seen 'Out of Hours' are brought to the Stratton branch for appointments with the Veterinary Surgeon. It is well recognised that the interests of pets are best served by examination and treatment at the veterinary practice. Pet owners are responsible for transporting their animals to the practice. Please consider how you might do this and have plans in place in case an emergency arises. In addition, the examination f of pets at the practice allows the duty

Under direction of the duty veterinary surgeon, an experienced veterinary nurse is working at the Stratton branch premises providing overnight care of hospitalised patients. Equine patients are hospitalised at the Holsworthy branch. The duty veterinary surgeon will be able to advise you of an estimate of costs for the 'Out of Hours' provision
